What are we learning this term?

Our Topic in school this term is linked to 'Explorers - what makes an

explorer important or

significant?'

Literacy and Phonics

The children will be completing baseline assessments for the first few weeks of school and we will then begin learning the Set 1 phonics sounds together, 4 sounds per week, along with the Red words.

Through our Literacy the children will be looking at a book a week using Greg Bottrill's pioneering approach 'The Drawing Club'. We will start with 'The Colour Monster' next week.

Maths

Following the Mastering Number approach, pupils will build on previous experiences of number from their home and nursery environments, and further develop their subitising and counting skills. They will explore the composition of numbers within 5. They will begin to compare sets of objects and use the language of comparison

Communication and Language

The children will learn a range of poems songs and rhymes, noticing the rhyming words and beginning to suggest alternatives.

Children will be encouraged to listen carefully and make comments about what they have heard and ask questions to clarify their understanding. Children will also be encouraged to offer explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems when appropriate.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Using PSHE Matters we will be looking at Being Healthy. The children will learn what a healthy diet is and how to take care of their bodies. They will learn about the importance of good hygiene through hand washing and taking care of our teeth too.

Understanding the World

The children will begin exploring different materials and their properties, finding out about why some materials are better than others for different tasks. They will begin looking at beebots and unplugged instructions in Computing. Through our Topic link they will find out about some famous explorers and their lives while looking at their own timelines so far. The children will also begin their Seasonal Walks exploring changes around us.

Expressive Arts and Design


Alongside exploring mark making materials and construction through play in class the children will also be looking at Drawings and Portraits in Art. How colour effects the mood of a piece of art work, how to use lines to create shapes and looking at some famous works of Art.

What are we learning this term?

English

Children will be reading the books *Class Two at the Zoo, Who's Our New Teacher?* and *Aaaarrgghh, Spider! They will* predict how the different stories will end, and then retell them in their own words.

Children will also be exploring poetry, patterns and rhymes and create their own poems to perform out loud.

Maths

Year 1—numbers to ten, the part, whole model and addition within 10

Uses of everyday materials.

Children will explore the properties of a range of everyday materials, their suitability, how some materials can change shape, how the recycling process is able to reuse some materials and learn about some inventors who created useful materials.

RE

Creation

Children will explore what Christians believe about the creation of the universe and how important it is to look after the world we live in.

Computing

Online safety and effective searching

Children will learn how to use Purple Mash and the importance of safely logging on and off. Children will also develop an understanding of what the Internet is and basic tools to help them search for information more effectively.

Topic

History— Explorers

Children will learn about some key explorers from around the world and from our local area and ask why they are important. They will be exploring timelines and getting a deeper understanding of the concept of significance.

Music

I wanna play in a band!

Children will be listening to a range of rock music, finding the pulse and clapping the rhythm and learning to sing a rock song and accompany it using percussion instruments.

PHSE

Being healthy

Children will explore what it means to be healthy by learning what makes a healthy lifestyle; the importance of brushing teeth, hygiene, exercise and a balanced diet.

PE

Real PE—Children will work on their coordination and balance through hopping, jumping, skipping, galloping and stopping and starting. They will explore these through a range of games and songs.


Art

Drawing and colour

Children will use a range of media to explore colour, texture, tone and shadow. They will then use these skills to create observational drawings.


