




Plastic, the Environment & Ecobricks


We are part of the environment-- a web of interconnections. We effect everything in it just as






In the natural environment everything works in circles of 100% use and resuse.

Recycling isn't a perfect circle like nature.




There are different grades of plastic. Check out the number on your bottle or container.

Plastic is down-cycled from one grade another. The lower the grade the less the value. The less the value, the less likely it is to be recycled.




In the end every molecule of plastic that we consume ends up in the Environment.



These plastics don't fit into the ecosystems that sustain us and our fellow species.



The UV rays from the sun cause plastic to break down into smaller and smaller pieces. This process creates more poisonous molecules that enter the ecosytem.






So what can we do?

- Be conscious of our consumption.
- Switch from plastics to organics.
- Start making ecobricks with our leftover plastics
- Teach others how to make ecobricks and build something great for the community.


Ecobricks are a solution.

Ecobricks leverage the long-life span of plastics to make a building block that can be used over and over again. This means we can take plastic out of deadend line, and put it into a circle of use and resuse.



Pack Ecobricks with non-biodegradebles only.







Use a stick to pack the bottle super tight. Get as much in to maximize space and make a solid brick.

Use a colored soft plastic to give the brick bottom a color. This will make your ecobrick constructions colorful!





Use the same brand of bottle so that all your bricks are the same. This will make building easier.



Log each ecobrick as it comes in. This way you can track your community progress.
